

VIRTUAL HOME WORKSTATION ASSESSMENTS

Supporting employers who have workers in a home environment to reduce the risk of injury



Employers have a duty of care to provide a work environment for employees which is safe and without risks to health, including working from home arrangements.

Employers will be able to:

- Determine if current working from home arrangements are appropriate and the risks are managed, so far as is reasonably practicable.
- Reduce the risk of workers compensation claims as a result of poor ergonomics and lack of appropriate working from home arrangements.
- Identify if workers require additional emotional and mental health support.
- Engage an independent, suitably competent and qualified safety professional to identify the hazards and risks associated with employees who work from home.

Employees will be able to:

- Feel confident the new working environment is appropriate for the work to be carried out.
- Understand best practice emotional and mental health strategies when working from home.
- Self-adjust their workstation to prevent injury and promote optimum work performance

How does it work?

- Virtual consultation with a suitably competent and qualified safety professional.
- Individuals are coached and mentored about appropriate ergonomic set up.
- Discussion and review of ergonomics, workstation set up, home office environment, communication requirements, mental and emotional wellbeing and availability of safe working procedures (i.e. incident reporting, emergency management).
- Issues are identified and a modification of the workstation undertaken.
- Resources Provided: Working from Home Guideline and Home Workstation Checklist
- Email summary with suggested recommendations for improvement provided to employer and worker.
